

HELPFUL HINTS

- Passenger Stop conducts travel planning presentations for groups of 10 or more. Call for reservations.
- Photocopy passport photo/vital statistics page, credit cards and drivers license. Put copy in luggage and one in traveling companion's bag.
- Take only those credit cards and keys that you will need.
- Security belt worn under clothing is safest way to carry passport, credit cards, and travelers' checks.
- Almost everywhere **but** in the U.S., electric current operates at 220V. Check your American appliance for dual voltage switch. If there is none, you will need a special electrical converter and adapter plug. If in doubt, ask us, we will try to help you out. You may want to purchase a dual voltage appliance.
- Pack a flat rubber sink stopper. Sinks and tubs often lack a stopper. You'll be grateful when you need to wash out undies or soak your tired feet.
- Flashlight and binoculars will come in handy for viewing murals and tapestries in poorly lit buildings.
- A hand held mirror will help you view ceilings without neck strain.
- A pair of comfortable walking shoes. Many historic buildings forbid high heels.
- Scotchgard your umbrella, shoulders of raincoat, jackets, and legs of slacks.
- Smart travelers read books and maps well in advance of their trip.
- Books, games, needlework or puzzles to help pass time while waiting.
